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### **FAVOURITE VIEWS OF FEERING**

View from Inworth Road to Messing

Cricket Ground

River Blackwater

Church environs

Field footpaths

The more you nibble away at a piece of cheese it will be gone - just like the countryside

### **MAP STICKERS:**

Around Feering church x3

Across the railway line, east of Feering church

Inworth Road east across the field

Bottom of Feering Hill by the Sun Inn x2

### **HEDGEROWS & TREES THAT YOU WOULD LIKE PROTECTED**

MAP sticker sheet only, no post-it note sheet:

Feering green

North side of the railway line / Lady Meadow

### **WHAT (ROAD) SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS WOULD YOU LIKE TO SEE?**

MAP stickers:

Cross-roads at The Tavern / Station Road/ Feering Hill / the High Street

Off road route from Inworth Road / Threshelfords towards Kelvedon

Inworth Road x2

Crossing Coggeshall Road by the rafted path footpath

Junction of Coggeshall Road & London Road x3

### **PAVEMENTS & FOOTPATHS**

The pavement opposite the Blue Anchor Pub - car park side - becomes flooded during rainfall.

Requires better drainage.

The pavement which floods opposite the Blue Anchor.

Footpath to Tiptree via Inworth Road

Pavement needed in Inworth Road where there is none.

Pavement along Inworth Road - pathway needs widening.

Pavement along London Road - Coggeshall to New Lane - pathway needs widening.

Inworth Road needs widening or something especially in view of new housing

Footpath to station from Rye Mill Lane via Cricket Club & Lady Meadow - so off the main road

Path over the bridge of the Blackwater River.

Improved footway / pavement on Blackwater Bridge at the bottom of Feering Hill - wide enough for  
2 buggies to pass

### **CYCLING**

Fewer lorries through the village

Heavy traffic through the village - cycle paths would encourage people / children to cycle rather than  
walk

Speeding in village put people off cycling & walking

Pot holes in High Street repaired for safer cycling

Cycleway link from Threshelfords to Feering Hill for off-road access to Kelvedon & facilities

Cycle route from cricket club to Lady Meadow to Coggeshall & Kelvedon

Off-road cycle path Kelvedon - Coggeshall

Holes in cycle track on A12 Kelvedon to Marks Tey

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### CROSSING POINTS

Speeding through the village

Zebra crossing at London Road by Ridgeons (*Note: currently a central refuge*)

Safe zebra crossing for Mums & buggies across London Road to Coggeshall Road

Across The Street to the green / the church

### LIGHTING

Street lighting required at Rye Mill Lane

Very dark bit on Rye Mill Lane - need a light

Share responsibility for lighting between the Parish & Lighting Company

### ANY OTHER AREAS

Improved sightline looking S/SE at the Coggeshall Road/ London Road junction

Access for Tiptree via another exit on A12 - this would reduce traffic through Feering & Kelvedon

Junction A12 to keep traffic [*? from*] coming through the village
