TELL IT TO THE KIDS!

RET have been focused on road safety outside schools.

The team worked closely with two primary schools in Uttlesford to drive down speeding and keep children safe.

The team visited the schools & talked to the children about road safety. Speed checks were then run outside the school with pupils assisting. When a speeding motorist was stopped, they were given the option to avoid a ticket if they agreed to speak to the children, providing they were only slightly over the

speed limit.

This proved highly impactful and all drivers reported they would be much more aware of their speed going past schools in future.



Over the day 2 drivers were prosecuted for not having insurance, 2 for speeding, 5 for parking on school zig zags and 14 drivers spoke to pupils about their speed.

RET TRACKS STOLEN GOODS

RET will go anywhere to find and recover stolen vehicles and return property to its rightful owner.

June saw the team recovering stolen items across Essex.

In Thurrock we recovered a stolen Land Rover Defender.



Also in Thurrock on the same day we found stolen items of plant.



Later in the month the team recovered two stolen mopeds, one in Saffron Walden, the

other in Chelmsford.



And finally a high value dumper truck was found after its tracking device activated in Brentwood, before being traced to Boreham in Chelmsford. The dumper was on the back of a lorry about to be driven out of the county and probably abroad.



Theft of vehicles and plant from rural locations is a priority for the team.

In the past 12 months the team have recovered over 60 stolen vehicles and items from across the county.

HERITAGE FOCUS

RET lead the force on heritage crime matters.

In June we investigated damage being caused at Southchurch Manor House in Southend.

Ancient stones under the moat bridge had been moved.

Working with staff, we gave advice on security and ensured our precious heritage was safeguarded.



All RET officers have heritage awareness qualifications from Historic England.

We have been visiting historic sites across Essex to show a visible presence and help safeguard our heritage.

In June we have visited Ongar Railway Station, the Essex Regiment Chapel in Warley as well as



many other significant historic sites.



STOLEN DOG RETURNED

Working with CID, RET were able to trace and recover a stolen dog and return her to her very grateful owner.

Pearl was taken during a house burglary in Halsted in May. Two people have been arrested on suspicion of burglary.

Following an appeal to find Pearl, information was received which led the team to an address in Tendring where Pearl was found safe and well.

We also attended the Essex Police, Fire & Crime Commissioners conference in Colchester.

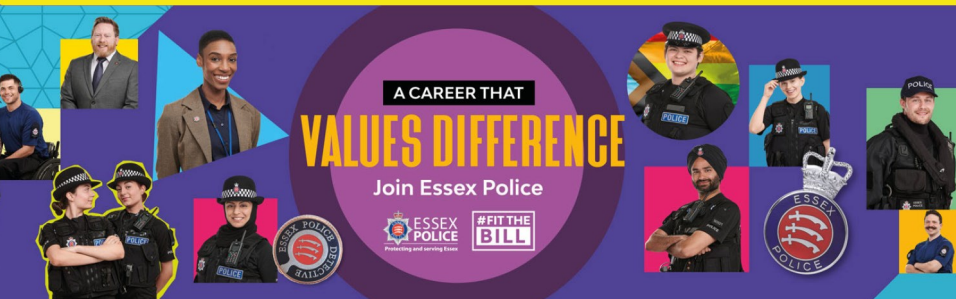
