1) **DISCUSSION OF THE FOLLOWING APPLICATIONS**

a) **23/02060/TPO – Feering Vicarage, 11 Feering Hill**

Comments by Councillors: Wellingtonia is quite close to the house at the back and work probably necessary. Defer to the BDC warden and in principle no objection to the Wellingtonia. If the tree warden recommendation that the Red Oak is to be felled request that another suitable species be planted.

Delegated response: Feering Parish Council would like to defer this application to the BDC Tree Warden. In principle the Parish Council has no objection to the work being undertaken on the Wellingtonia. However if the BDC recommendation is to fell the Red Oak, we would request that a suitable species replacement should be planted in a suitable location as part of the climate emergency which Feering Parish Council have declared.

b) **23/02009/PLD – 38 Watermill Road**
